EACH of the 3 CW-related 'Agreements' (Hague Declaration, Geneva Protocol, CWC) has weaknesses



'Agreements'

- 1899 Hague Declaration: "The Contracting Powers agree to abstain from the use of all <u>projectiles</u>, the sole object of which is the diffusion of asphyxiating or <u>deleterious gases</u>"
- <u>1925 Geneva Protocol</u>: "Protocol for the Prohibition of the <u>Use in</u> <u>War</u> of Asphyxiating, Poisonous or <u>Other Gases</u>, and of Bacteriological Methods of Warfare"
- 1993 Chemical Weapons Convention: "Convention on the Prohibition of the Development, Production, Stockpiling and Use of Chemical Weapons and on Their Destruction" [also prohibits use of RCAs as a method of warfare]
